There are safety fears for a missing teenager from Northwoods who has not been seen for 72 hours. Search parties have as yet been unsuccessful in locating 14-year-old Eva who has been missing since last week.

She was last seen heading in the direction of the bridge at 3pm Sunday, October 20. Eva was last seen before the fog and has not been seen since


Locals have been conducting a grid search of the surrounding woods and police are now appealing for information from the public that may help to locate her.

A Northwoods PD spokesperson said: "Anyone who has seen Ewa or knows of her whereabouts is asked to call us directly."

Eva's devasted parents say she knew better than to go out in the fog but deny reports she stormed from the house after an argument. Eva is described as five feet, nine inches tall, of a slim build and with very long, dark hair.
