SEARCH FOR MISSING TEEN ENTERS THIRD DAY

Fears Rise for Missing Girl

There are safety fears for a missing teenager from Northwoods who has not been seen for 72 hours. Search parties have as yet been unsuccessful in locating 14-year-old Eva who has been missing since last week.

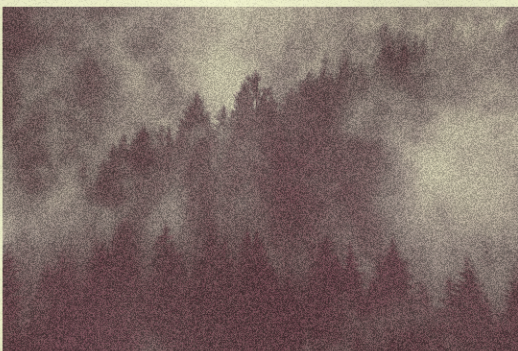
She was last seen heading in the direction of the bridge at 3pm Sunday, October 20. Eva was last seen before the fog and has not been seen since

Locals have been conducting a grid search of the surrounding woods and police are now appealing for information from the public that may help to locate her.

A Northwoods PD spokesperson said: "Anyone who has seen Eva or knows of her whereabouts is asked to call us directly."

Eva's devastated parents say she knew better than to go out in the fog but deny reports she stormed from the house after an argument. Eva is described as five feet, nine inches tall, of a slim build and with very long, dark hair.

A COMMUNITY IN SHOCK

Northwoods is on high alert after a popular high-school student disappeared, seemingly into thin air. Eva Zimmerman, 15, was out walking with friends in the woods behind the school when she got separated in the panic when the strange fog descended on town.

The teen was last seen heading out of Northwoods from her home in The Rise in the afternoon of October 20. Concerns grew after fog descended on Northwoods while she was out of the house.

Northwoods officials say they are still searching for the 14-year-old girl who has been missing for 3 days.

Standing on the steps of City Hall, Mayor Frank Irvine and Police Chief Raymond Dalton sought to assure the worried public they were doing everything they can to locate the teen.

Officials are offering a reward of up to \$1,000 for information that leads to the girl's return. It is hoped Eva saw the fog approaching and took refuge in a nearby home.

The strange fog fell on Northwoods on Sunday afternoon, leaving residents shaken. The mysterious mist enveloped Northwoods from all sides until visibility fell to almost zero, one baffled local (who wished to remain nameless) claiming, 'I couldn't see to the end of my porch.'

The girl's family has also organized a Tuesday evening search party, which will meet at 5 p.m. at the bandstand in the town square. A prayer service is also scheduled for Friday at 5:30 p.m. at St. Matthew's Church.
